Historical Background

The vision of Director's & respective members of Swati Educational Society, Raipur C.G., Resulted in a Health care system in the form of "School of Nursing"-"Kalindi Academy of Nursing Science' Mahasamund, Dist. Mahasamund (C.G.)

The School of Nursing was started in July 2011. The school grew under auspices of the C.G. Nurses. Registration council, Raipur and recognized by the "Indian Nursing Council" (INC) New Delhi.

The curriculum is three and half year Diploma Programme resulting in registered Nurse midwife (G.N.M.)

The school Building:-

A separate building exists with 04 lecture rooms. 01 demonstration room, 01 science lab, MCH lab, Nutrition lab, Anatomy lab, Computer lab, Community health lab and well equipped library and assembly hall.

Climate:-

The climate here is very hot in summer and cold in winter the monsoon are good.

PURPOSES:-

The main purpose of G.N.M. course is to provides educational programmes through which the graduates will be prepared to assume—responsibility in primary, secondary and tertiary care of people as professional Nurse. The essential elements of Nursing practice are those that are related to maintain and restore normal life functions, assessing patients physical, emotional states environmental factors formulating and implemental plan for the provision to Nursing care based on scientific principles . In providing these services the nurse's function as a member of the health team. It is expected that graduates are capable of teaching and supervising appropriate Nursing and Health care in different setting and participate in administration of Nursing services and education.

DESCRIPRIPTION OF GENERAL NURSING PROGRAMME:

Kalindi Academy of Nursing Science's (School of Nursing) Mahasamund, offers a Diploma Programme which is three and Half years text books and instructions are in Hindi / English. Examination are taken by C.G.Nurses Registration Council Raipur, each year and may be written in Hindi /English on successful complition of the course a Diploma is awarded by state Nursing Council and Registration is done by state Nursing council Raipur. (C.G.)

Eligibility:

- 1. Both male and female candidates are eligible.
- 2. Candidates should have completed 17 years of age. The upper limit is 35 years.
- 3. Candidates shall have passed 12^{th} (10+2) or equivalent preferably with science subject.
- 4. Candidates should be medically fit and interested in nursing profession.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Application forms and prospectus can be obtained from 01st May till 30th June by paying Rs. 200.00 (amount subject to change)
- 2. Submit completed form in his/her own handwriting with attached requirement.
- 3. Complete application form must be submitted by 15th July . After this time no form will be accepted.
- 4. Attach attested photostate copy of the following.

 (a) Marksheet of 10th and 12th board examination.

Note: Do not send original documents by post but the original would be checked at the time of interview.

- 5. Attach one recent passport size photo.
- 6. Attach complete medical certificate.
- 7. *For selection interview*:
 - (a) Candidates must come on set date at their own expense and own arrangement for lodging and boarding.
 - (b) Selection committee will make final selection from group of candidates interviewed. (The decision of the KANS is final)
 - (c) Selected candidates will be informed in September and requested to submit fees Rs. 5000/- to secure his/her seat in the class. This fee is not refundable.
- 8. All candidates accepted will have a three month period of probation which is a part of the three and half years course.
- 9. School authorities have the right to take disciplinary action for any student whose conduct is not acceptable for Nursing.
- 10. Any change concerning Nursing education made by the examination board will be followed by all general Nursing student and faculty.
- 11. All Nursing students living in the hostel must abide by the school and hostel rules.

SCHOOL OF NURSING CALENDER

- 1. Prospectus and Application form are available from 01st may through 30th June.
- 2. Completed application form are accepted till 15th July.
- 3. Entrance examination and interviews are scheduled during August
- 4. Selected candidates are informed in the month of September.
- 5. First day of 01^{st} of October.
- 6. Vacation of 30 days is granted every year.
- 7. October through December is probation period
- 8. Written and practical Board examination in Aug. & Sept.

TIME TABLE AND LEAVE:

- 1 Each student has 8 hours of duty scheduled including class time and clinical experience each day.
- 2. 30 days vacation are granted every year.
- 3. Leave for own sisters and brothers wedding may be considered only if student can attend return within two days.
- 4. Leave for death of mother ,father ,brother ,sister and grandmother ,grandfather who live with may be considered for 3-4 days .
